## **Assessment**

### **Targeting Instruction**

*Focus: Addressing Weaknesses*

1. Use assessment data to identify skills in which a significant number of students demonstrate weakness and a need for reteaching.
2. Use appropriate assignments to focus instruction and practice during the next unit.
3. Form groups for peer tutoring by using one student's strength to assist with another student's weakness. Mix groups often and do not always allow one student to be the "weak" one.
4. Use targeted review games as activities.
5. Use individual student work as the basis for student conferences. Plan with the student what he or she needs to work on and how it can be done.
